Student Art Reception Coming Soon

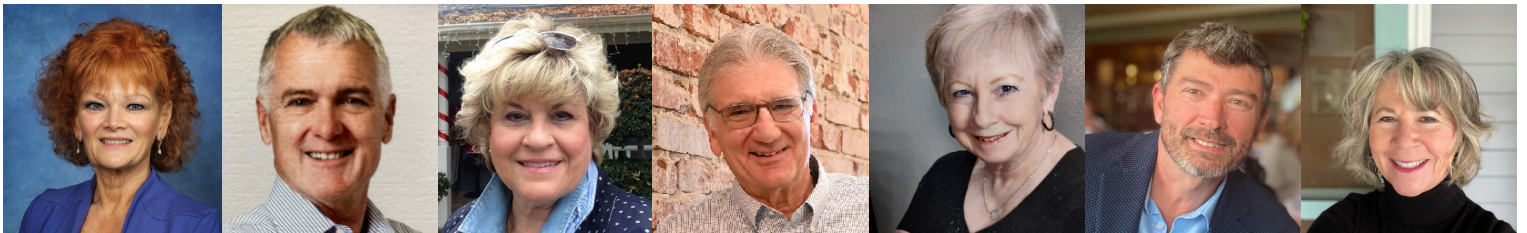
Save the date for CACHE's second annual *Future Artists of Exeter* student art reception on Wednesday, May 20, from 5:00 to 7:00 PM.
