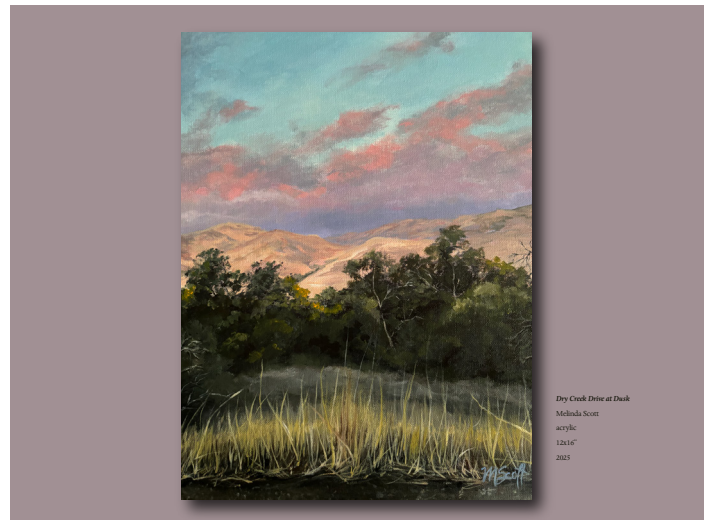


Brand New Solo Art Exhibit
